

## **PROOF OF IDENTIFICATION & ADDRESS**

All bidders and buyers must bring two forms of original identification and must select which forms of identification you have on the registration form, in order to register and receive a bidding paddle. Both forms of ID will need to be presented with the deposit monies following a successful bid. Please ensure you have one photographic and one proof of address and all documentation must be the original, as photocopies will NOT be acceptable.

## **PROOF OF ADDRESS**

- Current Full UK/EU Driving Licence\*
- Utility Bill no more than 3 months old
- UK Bank/Building Society Statement
- Local Authority Council Tax Bill
- State Pension/Benefit Book Notification\*

## **PHOTOGRAPHIC ID**

- Valid Signed Passport
- Current Full UK/EU Driving Licence\*
- Inland Revenue Tax Notification
- State Pension/Benefit Book Notification\*
- Resident Permit

## **ADDITIONAL INFORMATION REQUIRED**

- Are you purchasing a property jointly with others?
  - ID is required for each purchaser.
- Are you purchasing a property on behalf of a Limited Company, Limited Liability Partnership or unincorporated partnership or business?
  - ID for the bidder
  - Letter of Authority from the Company that you have authorisation to bid on the Company's behalf
  - Certificate of Incorporation
  - Full names of board of Directors/Partners
  - Proof of Registered Office Address
  - ID for Shareholders with more than 25% of share capital
- Are you bidding as an Agent for the buyer?
  - Letter of Authority from the Company/Individual that you have authorisation to bid on their behalf
  - ID for the bidder
  - ID for the buyer
- Are the providers of funds different to the bidder or buyer?
  - ID for the funds provider
  - ID for the bidder
  - ID for the buyer
- Are you bidding on behalf of a Trust?
  - ID for the bidder
  - ID for each beneficial owner
  - ID for the settler of the Trust
  - ID for each Trustee
  - Letter of Authority from the Trust that you have authorisation to bid on the Trust's behalf
